What is IELTS?

IELTS assesses all of 4 English skills — reading, writing, listening and speaking, and is designed to reflect how you can use English in study, in work, and in general. The IELTS test has been developed by some of the world's leading experts in language assessment and is constantly developed and updated. It has an excellent international reputation, and is accepted by over 10,000 organisations worldwide, including universities, employers, immigration authorities and professional bodies.

IELTS is the most widely accepted English language test that uses a face-to-face speaking test to assess your English communication skills. This means that you are assessed by having a real-life conversation with a real person. This is the most effective and natural way of testing your English conversation skills.

You can take **IELTS Academic or IELTS General Training**. The test you choose depends on the organisation you are applying to and your plans for the future.

Whatever your reason for taking IELTS, IELTS makes the most of your language skill.

IELTS test date availability across the globe

You can take your IELTS test with the **British Council** in over 130 countries. Many different test dates are available and tests typically take place up to once a week.

The British Council schedules the following global IELTS test dates:

- IELTS Academic: 48 days per year
- IELTS General Training: 24 days per year

This means that your local British Council test centre can offer IELTS tests on any of these days, although dates may vary in some centres, according to local demand.

You will usually take the Listening, Reading and Writing tests on Thursdays or more commonly Saturdays, and the Speaking test either on the same day, or up to seven days before or after that.



Every organisation sets its own entry requirements. In some cases both versions of IELTS may be accepted.

If you are in doubt as to which version to take, you should contact the organisations directly in order to check their requirements
